HOW TO APPLY

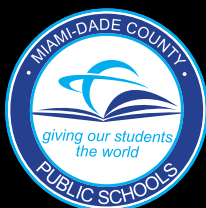

When the number of eligible applications exceeds the number of spaces available in a magnet program, a computerized random selection process is used for student selection. 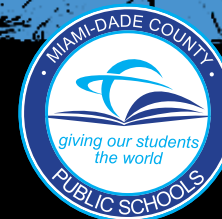

The Forensic Science Magnet at Country Club Middle School will offer students the opportunity to explore the exciting field of forensic science through hands-on experiences and inquiry-based learning, as they relate to the application of scientific studies and physical evidence. This new Magnet program will bring together different modalities of forensic investigation and examine career pathways that incorporate scientific inquiry through observation, collection and classification of data, examining relationships, forming and testing hypotheses, and making conclusions.



Curriculum Highlights

- Learn the techniques used in securing, searching, and examining evidence
- Learn techniques used to solve crimes
- Investigate the fundamentals of criminal law and the legal system
- Examine and analyze crime trends and prevention, justice policy, and statistics
- Discover basic criminological research methods
- Apply legal concepts including search and seizure, due process, use of force, and criminal liability
- Apply scientific research to law enforcement
- Gain a global perspective of the criminal justice process

Beyond: Post-Program A Bright Future Awaits

Students enrolled in the Forensic Science Magnet at Country Club Middle School will develop an understanding of law enforcement, the internal workings of the justice system, and the practice of examining physical evidence collected from a crime scene. Furthermore, this program will develop their skills in scientific analytic practices and law, while placing an emphasis on technology, as it is a vital component of crime solving.



Physical evidence cannot be intimidated. It does not forget. It sits there and waits to be detected, preserved, evaluated, and explained.

The Forensic Science Industry

The field of forensic science has become progressively sophisticated since the recent introduction of modern technologies such as laser scanners, drones and photogrammetry to obtain 3D point clouds of accidents or crime scenes. Forensic scientists are not only essential but increasingly more valuable within courts because of the accurate, methodical, detailed and unbiased scientific evidence they offer the judicial system.



Students enrolled in the Forensic Science Magnet program will learn technical terms and procedures based on scientific industry standards as well as hands-on experience. Students will be able to attain a wealth of intellectual information through the application of multiple science disciplines allowing them to arrive at intellectually sound conclusions for any criminal investigation.
